The North Pacific Fishery Management Council will meet at the Hilton Hotel in Anchorage Tuesday through Friday, and the agenda includes.

 Final consideration of limited access alternatives for the longline and pot sablefish fisheries off Alaska.

 Review of the limited access planning schedule for groundfish and crab fisheries.

- Inshore offshore allocations.
- Fishery research priorities.
 In addition, the council will select

proposed amendments to the groundfish fishery management plans for analysis before going to public review in April, discuss bycatch planning for 1990-91 and meet in joint session with the International Pacific Halibut Commission to discuss halibut management issues of mutual interest.

The council will meet in executive session at least once during the week to discuss personnel, ongoing litigation and international affairs.
