

In Position Paper—

Carr Calls for Education Guarantee for Every Child

According to a comprehensive position paper on education released today by Larry Carr, Democratic candidate for governor, the most important single function of government is "guaranteeing that every child will have an opportunity to secure an educational experience that will permit him to develop in life to his fullest capability."

The Anchorage businessman's study of the education scene ranged over a wide variety of subjects: From special education to

satellites, from relevance of education to earning power, from hot lunches to drug problems, from vocational education to more effective school boards.

The Carr position paper zeroed in on one of the key issues of education today: The early years and the greater learning ability latent there and not exploited.

The Democratic candidate's paper puts it this way: "Latest scientific knowledge about the development of intelligence dis-

closes that as much development takes place in the first five years as in the next thirteen."

"Our most effective use of the educational dollar, therefore" Carr said, "is in programs of early training. The state must have a program that extends pre-school opportunities to all children."
