

Statewide instructional support sys.

In recent action the Alaska State Board of Education created a policy advisory board for the Statewide Instructional Support System. Appointed to the advisory group were Katherine Hurley, Anchorage; Carolyn Wohlforth, Anchorage; Robert Van Houte, Juneau; Robert Green, Kodiak; Jim Zuelow, Bethel; and Marilou Madden, Juneau.

The Statewide Instructional Support System will involve the development of several programs, including a student testing system; an instructional resource distribution system; a staff training system; and a

management system designed to integrate program operations.

The instructional resource distribution is being developed by Robert Lehman, Department of Education, while the development of staff training is being directed by Ron Daugherty at Alaska Methodist University.

The policy advisory group will consider such areas as program definition, program operations and coordination with other programs. Development of the total program is being coordinated by Frank G. Nelson through Planning and Research, Department of Education.
