

# TT Board Approves \$10 Per Yr. Subscription Rate

An executive committee of five members of the board of directors of the Eskimo, Indian, Aleut Publishing Co. came into

existence at the company's March 5 board meeting.

The committee, which is composed of Tundra Times editor Howard Rock, Tom Richards, Laura Bergt, Betty Wescott and Dorothy Perdue will carry on the business of the company

between board meetings and when a quorum is not present.

The board of directors also finalized new single copy and subscription rates for the Tundra Times, to go into effect May 7. The new rates will be 25 cents

for each single copy.

Regular subscriptions will cost \$10 per year, \$18.75 for two years and \$5.50 for six months. Air mail subscriptions will be raised to \$21 per year, \$40 for two years and \$12 for six months.

The new rates were decided upon at the suggestion of the company's stockholders, in order to conform with the recent and proposed hikes in postal rates.
