

Game Officials Pool Resources Catching Bear Hide Smuggler

JUNEAU—A Fish and Game Department official credited other state and federal agencies for their help in stopping a shipment of illegal brown bear hides.

"The Bureau of Sport Fish and Wildlife, U. S. Customs, Canadian Authorities and other federal agencies all helped in the investigation which led to the arrest of an Anchorage guide who

had the illegal hides in his plane," said Wallace Noerenberg, Commissioner of the Department of Fish and Game.

"We are now approaching the end of the brown bear season when this type of activity increases," Noerenberg said, "and these agencies are continuing to assist the state in its efforts to halt the shipment of illegal hides."

Fish and Game Department personnel worked on the case for months before arresting guide Stuart Ramstad May 22 when he landed his plane in Juneau.

He pleaded guilty to seven counts of illegal transportation and possession of brown bear hides and one count of failure to provide information necessary for sealing a brown bear hide.

Ramstad was fined \$1,000 on each of the eight counts with \$250 suspended on each count.
