**CINA Endorses Alaska Plan**

Last week at their Board of Director's meeting, Cook Inlet Native Association voted to endorse the concept of the Alaska Plan.

The Board also endorsed the stand of the Aleut League in their opposition to Senator Harris's Bill S-1315. C.I.N.A felt that S-1315 will interfere with the livelihood of the Aleuts.

Other business discussed involved investigating the possibility of an advisory panel made up of volunteer business and professional people from the Anchorage area.

They, next fall according to Elaine Walbroek, deputy director of a Special Master of Public Health Project.

"We anticipate recruiting an equal number for the following year. Any circulatorization of this information that you can give would be very welcome," she writes.

Full tuition to the University of California is offered with traineeship stipends for living expenses available at \$3,600 base and \$500 for each dependent.

Students must be a Native American and have a Bachelor's degree from college. Graduates will find employment openings in many agencies: health facilities, hospitals, health services, planning groups, health delivery systems and in many other areas.

The weapon to be used is that school's 1971-72 Title I Project, available to schools through P.L. 8910, Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.

The Colville, a large river flowing northward from the Brooks Range to the Arctic Ocean, is the west boundary of the Arctic Wildlife Range.

This little known river has become an important place name with the discovery of Alaska's north slope oil.

The river was named by explorers of the Hudson Bay Company for Andrew Colville, an official of the company.

Three Giant Steps is the name of Chilocco's Project aimed at reducing student deficiencies in reading and mathematics, and decreasing the dropout rate at the school.

Approximately 300 students will raise their achievement level two years in reading and math through the contracted services of consultants from Wichita State University.

Parents of students will be in-

vited to live in dormitories in an effort to help students adjust to boarding school life.

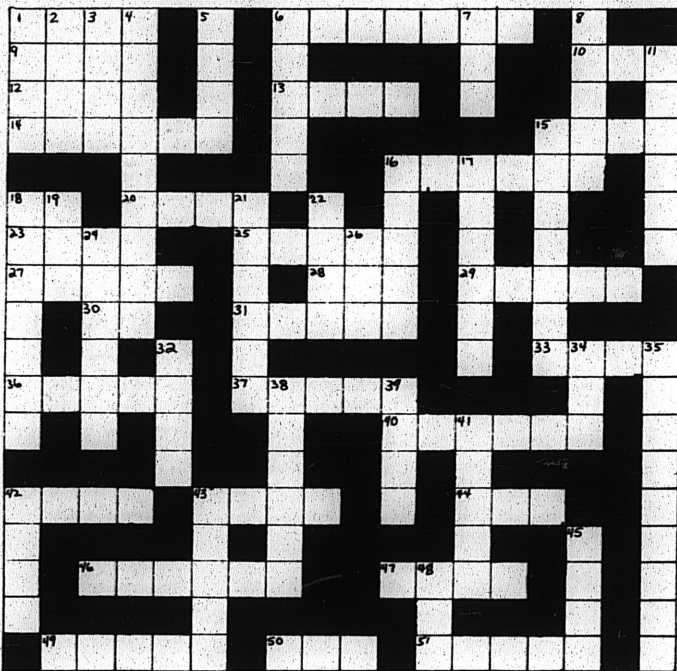
A work-study program, special counseling services through a social services representative, and educational field trips and assemblies will all be aimed at keeping our young people in school.

Chilocco, established in 1884, is located in extreme north central Oklahoma and is maintained by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
