Alaska Division of Aviation Awarded—Anchorage Airport to Get \$516,131, St. Mary's \$694,336

The Alaska Division of Aviation has been awarded a total of nearly \$1.2 million for airport improvements, according to Senator Ted Stevens.

Anchorage International Airport will receive \$516,131 for erosion control and to construct a service road.

St. Mary's Airport at Andreafsky will receive \$694,336 to lengthen a runway from 5,600 feet to 6,400 feet and widen it from 200 to 300 feet.
