This project will consist of grading and drainage on 7.7 miles of gravel roadway near Delta Junction, Alaska. Principal items of work consist of the following: 212,000 cubic yards of unclassified excavation; 226,000 tons of Selected Material; 56,500 tons of subbase grading C; approximately 2,300 linear feet of pipe conduit ranging in size from 18" diameter to 72" diameter; 75,000 square feet of seeding; construction of a protective casing or sleeve for 8" high pressure oil line, lump sum, all required; and miscellaneous items of work. recognize that the goal is the right one for their own educational progress.

Exploring the possibility of taking over some BIA functions (which already has been done with success in Southeast Alaska), as Mr. Hensley proposes, would be a progressive move by the AFN. Conversion of the Wildwood Station to an educational facility also has merit.

For the AFN simply transfer the Mt. Edgecumbe School function to a new location, however, would be extremely shortsighted, or worse, could be interpreted as the Natives' intention to maintain segregated boarding schools indefinitely.

They should set their sights higher than that.

from Kenai and Wildwood occasionally to places like Anchorage and Fairbanks and other communities in that area offer exciting educational and social possibilities.

Besides that, it may be possible to offer adequate vocational studies for not only the students themselves, but other people from rural and urban areas in Alaska who would be able to use the facilities that are available for sheetmetal work, plumbing, carpentry, mechanics and painting. There is a gymnasium, shooting range, bowling alley, soda fountain and other benefits that could be useful to the students.

Further, it is my understanding that the Department of Education and the Bureau of Indian Affairs are also concerned about bringing back many students from Chemawa, Oregon, where they have been attending school; and this, too, has great merit; and I think that it is unwise to think that students from Westward Alaska will continue attending high school at Mt. Edgecumbe for many years into the future.

I believe that the abandonment of the Mt. Edgecumbe facility will offer new opportunities for the community of Sitka to design an economic base utilizing the Island. There is no doubt that there are many fond memories by many students of Sitka and Mt. Edgecumbe who attended school there. If it were not for the care and attention of people who live in Sitka and Mt. Edgecumbe, many may not have finished high school, yet changing times and changing ideas of education, and unfortunately age and decay, bring about the need to look for other means to provide an education for our students.
