JUNEAU — Construction will
begin soon on Prince of Wales
Island's first airport, Governor
William A. Egan said.

The Southeast Alaska island
now is served only by float and
amphibious airplanes.

A \$1.1 million Public Works
contract, Egan said, has been
awarded to South Coast Forest

Products company for construc-
tion of the new airport between
Klawock and Craig.

The Work includes construc-
tion of a 2,500 - foot gravel
runway, a 3,800 - foot access
road, a taxiway and an aircraft
parking area.

The project is scheduled for
completion in early 1974.
