Pt. Hope News recounted the unique arrangement in the following manner:

"PHCAP will be temporarily halt for whaling season sometimes in April. The period of hunting for the staff of PHCAP will be for one month.

"This whaling season is one of the biggest events of the year at Pt. Hope."

Other officers are James W. Thomas, Cordova, secretary; Mrs. Beatrice Watson, Ketchikan, treasurer; and Steven Hotch, Klukwan, Frank See, Hoonah, Charles Olson, Sitka and Henry Littlefield, Metlakatla, vice presidents.

The council is the legislative body recognized by Congress to represent the 12,000 Tlingets and Haidas of Southeast Alaska in their claims against the government for land judgment funds.


