

Univ. of New Mexico Offers Law Program

The University of New Mexico Law School is offering a law program for American Indians this summer. The program will be held on the University of New Mexico campus in Albuquerque from June 19 to August 11.

There will be 15 Indian students selected to receive full scholarship to cover room, board, tuition, travel, book stipends and a living allowance. Any American Indian who has completed at least two years of college may apply.

Those college seniors who successfully complete the summer will enter the UNM Law School in the fall on full scholarship.

During the summer the students will receive an introduction to legal studies and regular law

courses as well as special courses designed to develop skills necessary for superior law school performance. Also, there will be legal writing and group discussions of current legal problems.

Ex-Governor Joins Equitable

Former Alaska Gov. William A. Egan has joined the Equitable Life Assurance Society of the U.S. as a sales representative in Anchorage.

The company has a total of \$20 million in insurance policies in force in the state, and investments of more than \$35 million in real estate and in securities of companies with principal operations in Alaska.

Egan began his political career as a member of the Valdez City Council in 1937 and was elected mayor in

1946. He served five terms in Territorial House of Representatives and two terms in the Territorial Senate.

He was president of the Alaska Constitutional Convention in 1955-56 and was "Tennessee Plan

Senator" in Washington to promote Alaskan statehood, 1956-58. He began the first state governor in 1959 and was re-elected in 1963. Egan was defeated last fall by Walter J. Hickel, the current governor.

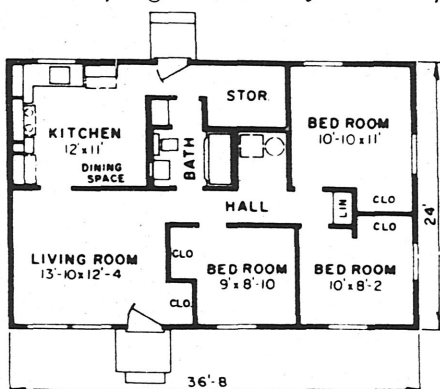

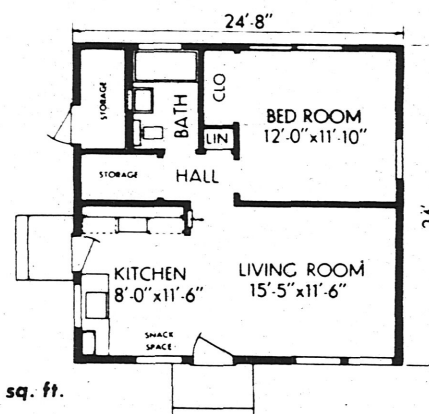
