SJC Course on Implementation of Land Claims—

Six Weeks Course Also Deals with Corporate Structure Directed by Wm. Paul, Sr.

Sheldon Jackson College in Sitka, Alaska has introduced a course to deal with some of the effects of the Federal land rights settlement for Alaska Natives.

The six week course "Corporation Structure and Implementation of the Land Claims" is currently holding sessions Tuesday and Thursday evening.

The seminar-type course, directed by William Paul, Sr., makes heavy use of experts in corporate structure and corporate law in exploring the specific provisions of the land claims act.

According to Dr. Orin R. Stratton, President of Sheldon Jackson College, the course is

the first attempt at offering the education necessary to provide the expertise to deal effectively

with the settlement.

It was developed as a result of the stated needs of the Sitka

Camp of the Alaska Native Brotherhood as well as a number of individuals and organizations.

KUAC-TV to Change Its Designation

FAIRBANKS — KUAC-TV at the University of Alaska has received permission from the Federal Communications Commission to change its designation from College to Fairbanks.

TV Coordinator Don Upham said the educational station had requested the change from the FCC after the university's Board of Regents decided last January the location of the campus would be called Fairbanks rather than College.

A similar change is pending for KUAC (FM), the university's radio station, but the paperwork has not yet been completed, Upham said.
