
# Will Rogers, Jr. to Keynote at

In Sitka for Alaska Day celebration, during the centennial year of the transfer of the territory to the United States, the visit was more than a celebration, for the present New York business man. Mr. Maxutov, because of the part his grandfather played in the transfer, said the visit to Sitka was like "coming Home."

He appeared deeply moved by the manner in which the community has preserved the historical relationship of his grandfather. He first visited the city in 1955.

A graduate of the University of Michigan as a Chemical Engineer in Petroleum Technology, Mr. Maxutov has been affiliated with the California Texas Oil Co. for a number of years. His home is in Pleasantville, New York.
