As passed by the subcommittee, the appropriations bill provides that village health clinics will be leased in 76 Alaskan villages by the Indian Health Service at a cost of \$456,000. Dental care programs operated by the Native Health Service for contract will be expanded to \$355,000.

Indian Health Service funds in the amount of \$100,000 will be used for the cost overrun on the clinic at the new Fairbanks Memorial Hospital.


