Summary of Ordinance 76-1

Ordinance 76-1 is a code ordinance  
and adopts sections 01.60.010,  
01.60.020 and 01.60.030 as a part of the ordinance  
and Title 1 of the Code of  
Ordinances of the North Slope  
Borough. The Ordinance accepts the  
transferring the police and jail  
facilities power and certain  
regulatory powers from the City of  
Barrow, Alaska and becomes  
effective July 1, 1976.

Summary of Ordinance 76-2

Ordinance 76-2 is a code ordinance  
and adopts sections 01.60.010,  
01.60.020, inclusive, as a part of the ordinance  
and Title 1 of the code of ordinances of the North  
Slope Borough. The ordinance  
creates a Disaster Assistance Agency  
for the North Slope Borough, Alaska  
and provides for its organizations.  
Specifically, the ordinance defines  
the purposes of the Disaster  
Assistance Agency, provides for a  
Director and his powers, defines the  
structure of the organization,  
provides for violations and penalties,  
membership in the Disaster  
organization and defines certain  
terms.
