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Ten Villages Slated For Electric Power

Ten Alaska villages will get electricity to light their homes this year according to Rep. Willie Hensley of Kotzebue and president of the Alaska Village Electrification Cooperative.

Kasigluk and Nunapitchuk, 15 to 20 miles apart in the Kuskokwim Delta area, will powered jointly. Emmonak and Alakanuk may be serviced the same way.

Hooper Bay, Kiana, Selawik, Noorvik, Nulato, Huslia, Grayling and Togiak round out the villages slated for electricity service.

Hensley said that there had been many other applicants for electricity power installations but that it was impossible to take care of them this year.

He said there is a good possibility that 67 Alaska villages will get electricity within the next three years.

Hensley and other AVEC members met in Anchorage last weekend to pick the above villages and to pick out a manager for the village electrification project.

The name of the manager has not been released but he is believed to be from New Mexico.

AVEC is operating through a \$29,220 Office of Economic Opportunity grant. The agency is to also train two residents from each of the villages picked to learn to operate electric plants.

This training is being funded through \$660,000 grant from the Department of Labor.

AVEC is slated to get a loan of about \$4 million from the Rural Electrification Administration to purchase equipment and their installation within the next three years.

Besides Rep. Hensley, other members of the AVEC are: Diane Carpenter, Stoney River, vice chairman; Morris Thompson, Juneau, secretary-treasurer; David Peterson, Juneau, director; and James Hoffman, Anchorage, director.

Food Stamp for Areas by July 1

Congressman Howard W. Pollock in a wire from his office in Washington said that all of the areas in Alaska that are not now participating in the food stamp program will be authorized to begin participating by next July 1.
