the hole always ready to shoot. Seals are invisible. Seals never the hole always ready to shoot. Seals are invisible. Seals never warns hunters whenever they wanted to blow through holes where this hunter sits.

Whenever hunter hears seal breathing through the holes, this

hunter very carefully raised his gun, aimed it through the hole and take a shot. Then he laid his gun took his harpoon, shopped the thin ice and spear the seal and pulled it off from the water.

That's how we Eskimos do

That's how we Eskimos do hunt them seals through holes.
We people here are much different in hunting seals through holes. We use guns. But along where I was in 1928 near Cambridge Bay, Canada, I've seen the more than uses only spear. Eskimos there uses only spear to kill seals through holes. It's

amazing.
SNOW-GO'S BREAKDOWN

It looks to us now that we people here in Barrow village do make mistakes killing good dogs which we should keep them for driving.

Because dogs don't break down like any vehicles around such as Ski-doos. Some men such as Ski-doos. Some then here do have troubles, left their Ski-doos and walk in to village sometimes they'd walk 25-30 miles. That's a long walk.
