We don't deserve what's under the ground if we don't preserve what's on top.



There's oil under your rocks, fields, and streams. America needs that oil.

But you need those rocks, fields, and streams. And the grass, the gravel, the birds, and fish that keep Alaska's nature in balance.

When we finish our drilling, we replace what we disturbed. When we disturb anything, in fact, we put it back together as close to, and sometimes better than, what it was.

And that's exactly what we'll go on doing.
