

Alaska Airlines Gets Stay— On Anchorage/Nome/Unalakleet/Kotzebue Run

WASHINGTON, D.C. — The Office of Congressman Nick Begich received notification from the Civil Aeronautics Board that a decision has been made to grant a stay on the Board's previous order suspending Alaska Airlines' Anchorage-Nome/Unalakleet/Kotzebue authority through February 7, 1979.

The C.A.B.'s previous opinion on September 25, 1972, awarded Wien Consolidated Airlines unrestricted authority over a similar route, on a nonsubsidy basis. Alaska Airlines' motion for a stay was granted only until further order of the Board.

The C.A.B. stated that its action with regard to service to Nome, Unalakleet and Kotzebue is closely interrelated to its award of the prior phase of the Alaska Service Investigation which is presently under review in the courts (Western Air Lines, Inc. et. al. v. CAB).

Approves \$1.1 Million— KNA Gets Training Funds from BLA

The Bureau of Indian Affairs has approved \$1.1 million in contracts for the Kenai Native Association for training Natives in construction skills, according to Senator Ted Stevens.

These funds will allow the Kenai Native Association to contract for training personnel, materials and student transportation. Because the Natives will do their own training, they will have a complete say in how the program is established and managed.

These funds became available through the Indian Action Team program, which provides manpower training and business development opportunities in the construction field.

These opportunities would be available to Natives in their home communities.
