NARL of Barrow Observes 25th Anniversary

A graduate student at the Naval Arctic Research Labora-tory at Barrow summed up his experience there as one in which the relaxed atmosphere between professors, graduate students, local Natives, and Arctic "veterans", and the 24 hour interaction and exchange was like receiving a dinner table education, "a university in a Quonet" Quonset".

From its beginnings in 1947 in a small Quonset to its present twenty-fifth anniversary, NARL has drawn strength from just this kind of informal, flexible, reaching, ever-growing format.

Past director for three-fifths of its life span, Max Brewer spoke at the anniversary celebration in Fairbanks, Aug. 14.

bration in Fairbanks, Aug. 14.

Brewer pointed to a quarter century of "lean and hungry, independent, and generally unfettered scientific research."

He cited the course by which it has continued to grow with increasing vitality and to escape the "doldrums of old age."

Studies conducted by the Laboratory have ranged over an incredibly rich variety of sub-

incredibly rich variety of subjects: lemnings, permafrost, underwater sound, ice studies, auroral observations, biology, geophysics, animal population, health, archaeology, anthro-

health, archaeology, anthro-pology, and many, many more. John F. Schidler, current director, commended the Native people of Barrow for their in-volvement from the very first summer of the Laboratory's

summer of the Laboratory's beginnings.

"For most of the lifetime of the Laboratory," said Schindler "about 60 per cent of our employees were hired locally, The difficulties that someone from the "South 48" can have trying to accomplish the simplest of chores in an Arctic winter can only be appreciated fully by those who've learned the hard way."

"The people of Barrow," he said, "have brought an experience and knowledge to the Laboratory the value of which is immeasurable to the research effort." beginnings.

"How many overland trips, ice projects, boat projects and ice stations owe their success to the presence and gentle

to the presence and gentle suggestion of the local people can never be known."

"I am very sure," Schindler concluded, "it is a great number and I now publicly express mine and the Laboratory express mine. and the Laboratory's gratitude to the Native people of Barrow."
