
Loans issued under the Commercial Fishing Revolving Loan Fund are not made to corporations or partnerships, but only to individual Alaskan fishermen.

The Fund was created to improve the efficiency of the existing fleet. Qualified individuals must have been continuous residents of the state for five years, and have had a comfive years and have had a com-mercial fishing license for at least three years.
