# Mike Urges Secretary of Labor to Release Alaska Plan Funds

Senator Mike Gravel has urged the Secretary of Labor to release funds for the Alaska Plan, a funds for the Alaska Plan, a program to train members of minority groups in order that equal employment policies can be implemented.

In a letter made public by his Washington office, Senator Gravel noted that President Nixon had endorsed that President Nixon had endorsed the strengthening of current programs rather than the creation of new programs to stimulate equal job opportuni-

The Senator pointed out to James Hodgson, Secretary of the U.S. Department of Labor, that current programs cannot be strengthened without the funding that has already been appropriate for the property of the property

ing that has already been approved for them.

According to the Alaskan Democrat, the Nixon Administration has held up funds for equal employment programs throughout the Nation. Until those funds are released, the Alaska Plan, and similar plans in states, are at a virtual

Senator Gravel said that the need for funding the Alaska Plan is "critical." He added that the Plan "is only worthless rhetoric unless the funds are there to support it."

According to Senator Gravel, business and labor groups in the State have developed goals for equal employment in Alaska. The funds are needed so that the goals can be reached. With-out the funds, a burden is placed on all elements of the Alaska economy.

"The businesses need to hire minority workers for contract compliance, but there are not enough trained individuals avail-able." Senator Gravel said.

"Labor groups would like to have the composition of their membership in line with that of the general population, but this is impossible without trained minority group members. And, most important, lack of training thwarts the economic advance-

bers.
"This is especially critical in Alaska. Federal contract com-Alaska. Federal contract com-pliance can be a problem for businessmen when adequately trained workers are not available

"It is a problem for Alaskans who will possibly lose out on the employment opportunities that will open up with construction of the Alaska pipeline," he said.

#### Studies Bridge

The first cable-stayed girder bridge in the United States has another first to its credit. The another first to its credit. The John W. O'Connell Bridge in Sitka is now the subject of the most extensive aerodynamic research project ever conducted on

The structure has recently gen instrumented for a neen instrumented Fer a study under joint sponsorship of the Alaska Department of Highways and the Federal High-ways Administration, U.S. De-nattment of Tenascontin. partment of Transportation, to investigate the aerodynamic be-havior of the cable-stayed bridge under the relatively high winds that occur in the Sitka area.

This is the first project in the United States where instruments of this degree of sophistication have been used to read bridge

have been used to read bridge responses.

Girder bridges in general are not subject to wind induced oscillation. However, suspension during relatively low wind velocities because they are designed to be more flexible.

This 450-foot main span

This 450-foot main span This 450-toot main span bridge is somewhat of a com-promise between a suspension bridge and girder bridge. Very little information is available on the aerodynamic characteristics of this type of structure, al-though several cable-stayed girder bridges are in use in Europe, Canada, and Japan.

Although the oscillations on this bridge should be minor, researchers are hoping to observe wind action sufficient to cause

the bridge to react in one or more of its natural frequencies. The data collected will be extremely valuable for the eval-uation of various structure shapes in model-wind tunnel tests, which will then allow the safe use of this graceful, eco-nomical structure on larger spans.

Five extremely sensitive three directional wind velocity meters have been installed on the south side of the bridge, and ten motion sensing devices (accelero-meters) have been installed along the edges of the concrete deck.
