

RESOLUTION 2

RESOLUTION 71-13

NORTH STAR III

WHEREAS: ALASKA NATIVE INDUSTRIES COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION, INC., (ANICA, Inc.) is a self-supporting Alaskan Native Association; and

WHEREAS: ANICA, Inc., ships vital food, petroleum, and other supplies to Alaskan coastal villages on the NORTH STAR and

WHEREAS: the split shipping schedule of the NORTH STAR allows ANICA, Inc., to spread its financial obligation and income sufficiently to operate on a non-government supported basis; and

WHEREAS: the assumption of services provided by the BIA vessel NORTH STAR by a commercial carrier would require ANICA, Inc., to purchase yearly supplies for ALL ANICA, Inc., and might result in the subsequent dissolution of the organization and resulting loss of services to the villages;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Directors of ANICA, Inc., protests any reduction of NORTH STAR services without total consultation with the Native

people served by the NORTH STAR.
