The federal courts put great weight in the views of the Conference Committee when deciding such disputes, and disagree with the Committee only on very rare occasions, according to

counsel for A.F.N. and Tundra Times.

This means that the definitive interpretation of the land claims bill is the Conference Committee's report, for almost all purposes.

"That error is actually not as horrendous as the totally inaccurate one under the small headline," said Miffie. It read: "10,000 Indians in the city try not to feel isolated."
