hunters were reported overdue or lost in Southeast alone with-out counting statistics from other parts of the State.

Additional information which can be filed are radio call letters, number in the hunting party, type of boat used, area of cruising, and time of departure.

"It only takes a minute to advise us by phone where you intend to go," concluded Commissioner Chapple. "Do that and much anxiety can be avoided by both our department and relatives of the hunters.
