TCC to Study Early Childhood Education

The Tanana Chiefs Conference, this week, received a grant from the Alaska Department of Education, State Operated Schools, to perform a preliminary study of early childhood education in interior Alaska.

The grant is for \$57,000 and runs for six months.

John Sackett stated that, "The purpose of the planning grant is to perform an in-depth review of what the residents in the interior villages wish to have by way of early childhood education.

"Different alternative methods will be presented, and all final decisions will be those of the residents. From this planning grant, we hope to derive a program which will be in every village, and of which the people are an active part."

Abby Ryan, Early Childhood Development specialist, has been named the director of this program. She will be assisted by additional personnel in traveling to the villages.

Alaska Plan To Incorporate

ANCHORAGE — The Alaska Plan Policy Board voted to incorporate under Alaska Statutes as a non-profit corporation and send a \$125,048 budget proposal to Washington, D.C. for financing an Executive Director and three (3) other staff positions.

The corporation will be known as the Alaska Plan Construction Opportunity Policy Board, Inc., said Board Chairman Robert Willard.

Willard presented a copy of the uniform bid conditions that becomes effective July 5. The document sets forth the minority-hire goals for construction projects all across the State which are federal or federally-assisted.

The Chairman also advised the labor-management and minority group representatives that the possibility of alignment of State projects with the Alaska Plan may come soon — at a time when Governor William A. Egan executes an Executive Order to accomplish that objective. Willard reported he is in contact with the Attorney General on the Governor's Order.

"Having been incorporated, the Policy Board would be eligible to receive and administer grants," Willard explained. The new corporation will elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer when it is organized and it will be the third organization created since development of the Plan began in the summer of 1970.
