Groseclose reported that another intensive search effort is expected to recommence shortly by the Canadian Search and Rescue Team which conducted a 2 week search in the Kluane Lake-Whitehorse area immediately following the February 11 report that the plane was mis-

Carter who is known to have Carter who is known to have made the flight on several past occasions had filed a highway flight plan. Miss Groseclose and Dr. Carter are both from Fairbanks, employed at the Tanana Valley Clinic.
