## Taxpayers Assn. Anti Borough

The question of the North Slope Borough continues to provoke interest in many quarters. An Anchorage group called the Alaska Taxpayers' Association, which has been in existence about three years, issued a statement June 9, in which they opposed the formation of the borough.

The group announced itself in support of the suit brought against the borough by seven major oil companies and private interests. They were also in favor of halting the June 20 election in the borough.

John R. Strachan, president of the Taxpayers' group, stated that "the proposed borough is an obvious attempt by a few people to acquire a disproportionate share of the state's tax wealth at the expense of the majority of Alaska taxpayers and in direct contradiction to the Alaska constitution."

The Anchorage Daily News listed other members of the association's board of directors as Richard Kennard, vice-president of Peoples Bank & Trust; Jo Ann Miller, secretary-treasurer of J.C. Penney Co.; M. F. Alewine of the Central Labor Council; Lew Dischner, Trust, Inc.; Frank Harris, Alaska Cleaners & Laundry; and Bruce Kendall, Roosevelt Hotel.

Kendall said that some members of the board were unhappy with the report and that "there will probably be some resignations" over the matter, his own included.

While most of the board was in agreement "that the North Slope Borough is in violation of the intent of the Constitutional convention," their disagreement is on the involvement of their own group, which Kendall says was formed initially to deal with local Anchorage government and issues.

With the statement issued this week, Kendall felt they were "going into the political arena and I didn't think they should be."

Kendall pointed out that some of the Association's members are active in state politics.

"The Native people are some of our supporters," he said.

The Taxpayers' Association is somewhat allied to the urban Anchorage interests that were defeated at the recent state Democratic convention, the business-labor bloc that the North Slope Natives rejected throwing in their political force with the Ad Hoc and the liberal Fairbanks group.

## Social Security Benefits Can Be Increased

Senator Ted Stevens (R-Alaska) has cosponsored legislation to increase the Social Security benefits of the Nation's Senior Citizens by 20 per cent.

Stevens said that Wilbur Mills, the House Ways and Means Chairman, has pointed out that the Social Security old age trust fund is heavily overfinanced and an increase of 20 per cent could be enacted without significant change.

"Our Senior Citizens urgently need this increase," Stevens said, "and I hope that it may be accomplished with dispatch by the Congress."

The amendment to H.R. 1 raised from 5 per cent to 20 per cent the old age benefits of the Welfare bill.
