ALASKA

No matter where you live—
No matter where you were born—

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL IF YOU ARE:

1. A Citizen of the United States.
2. A person of Native American, Eskimo, Aleutian, or Indian ancestry who is a resident of Alaska.
3. Born on or before December 13, 1971, and living in the State of Alaska.
4. Adopted children, step-children, etc. are eligible to enroll, too, if they meet the criteria in 1-3 above.

FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO HAVE ALREADY ENROLLED
BUT WISH TO CHANGE YOUR ENTRY IN COLUMN 16
(WHERE YOU WILL PROBABLY BE PERMANENTLY ENROLLED)
YOU MAY DO SO BY WRITING TO THE ENROLLMENT COORDINATOR.
