"The sign at the rapids was blown in half and five spent .12-gauge cartridges were lying on the ground nearby," he continued.

Hall suggested that the person wielding the shotgun had re-moved the plug to accommodate five shells.

"I walked down the trail and found three small trees shot-gunned down," continues Hall. He added that a Tongass Na-

Returning to town, about midway between Papke's Landing and Blind Slough, Hall found several more small trees, three or four inches in diameter, blown down by shotgun fire. The hunter described the destruction as a "pretty sad state of affairs."


