Exclusive use of the business names **ESKIMO OLYMPICS** and **WORLD ESKIMO OLYMPICS** has been registered in the State of Alaska by the Eskimo, Indian, Aleut Publishing Company, publishers of the Tundra Times.

The use of these names has been reserved with the State Department of Commerce for a period of five years, with an option for renewal under Chapter 35 of Title 10 Alaska Stat-

utes. Notification of the registration, signed by Commissioner

of Commerce Kenneth W. Kadow, was received February 23, 1971.

It isn't postmaster who signs the air bills, but the village Wien Agent or Acting Wien Agent...I would gladly appreciate an answer.
